Choirs are a significant part of the cultural heritage of German-speaking communities. The Association of German Teachers of Victoria Inc. is pleased to invite school choirs of 5 to 15 members of Foundation to Year 6 children to compete for the KINDERCHOR DES JAHRES PREIS.

Date: Saturday, 25th October 2014

Venue: Austrian Club in Heidelberg West in Melbourne

NB: Families will be invited to attend this inaugural event.

Description of the Competition:

School choirs prepare two songs from a set list to perform in German with or without accompaniment:

- 1 x Weihnachtslied chosen from the songs listed on the AGTV Frohes Fest CD-Rom*
- 1 x Volkslied chosen from: http://www.volkslieder-songarchiv.de/volkslieder.php **

Cost to enter: There is no entry fee.

Who can enter?

Children's choirs from AGTV member schools with:

- a minimum of 5 and maximum of 15 members
- children from Foundation to Year 6

Rules of the Competition:

- Only one instrument is allowed to accompany the performance.
- No solo performances.
- Music sheets for the children are allowed.
- No props. Uniforms/ costumes are allowed.

Prizes:

- First, Second, Third Prizes awarded in each category (Weihachtslied and Volkslied)
- KINDERCHOR DES JAHRES PREIS and invitation to sing at a performance of the Alpine Singers of Melbourne and at the AGTV/GI Presentation Evening in November.

All choir members will receive a certificate of participation.

Closing Date for Registration of Participation: Monday, 8th September 2014

NB: Entry forms will be forwarded after this closing date.


Criteria for judging:
